

#### **The Facts**

All sexual activity between an adult and a child is sexual abuse. Sexual abuse does not have to involve penetration, force, pain, or even touching. If an adult engages in any sexual behavior (looking, showing, or touching) with a child to meet the adult's interest or sexual needs, it is sexual abuse.

Sexual touching between children can also be harmful, and in some cases abusive.







# Prevention Tasks Infants and Toddlers - Teach language for all body parts, including genitals - Allow child to explore own body; do not shame them for being curious - Respond to questions about sexuality honestly but simply - Healthy physical contact - Provide warm, safe and loving environment - Allow them to say no to hugs, kisses, etc.

- Everyone needs to be touched!
- · Healthy touch prevents sexual abuse


#### **Talking about Consent**
